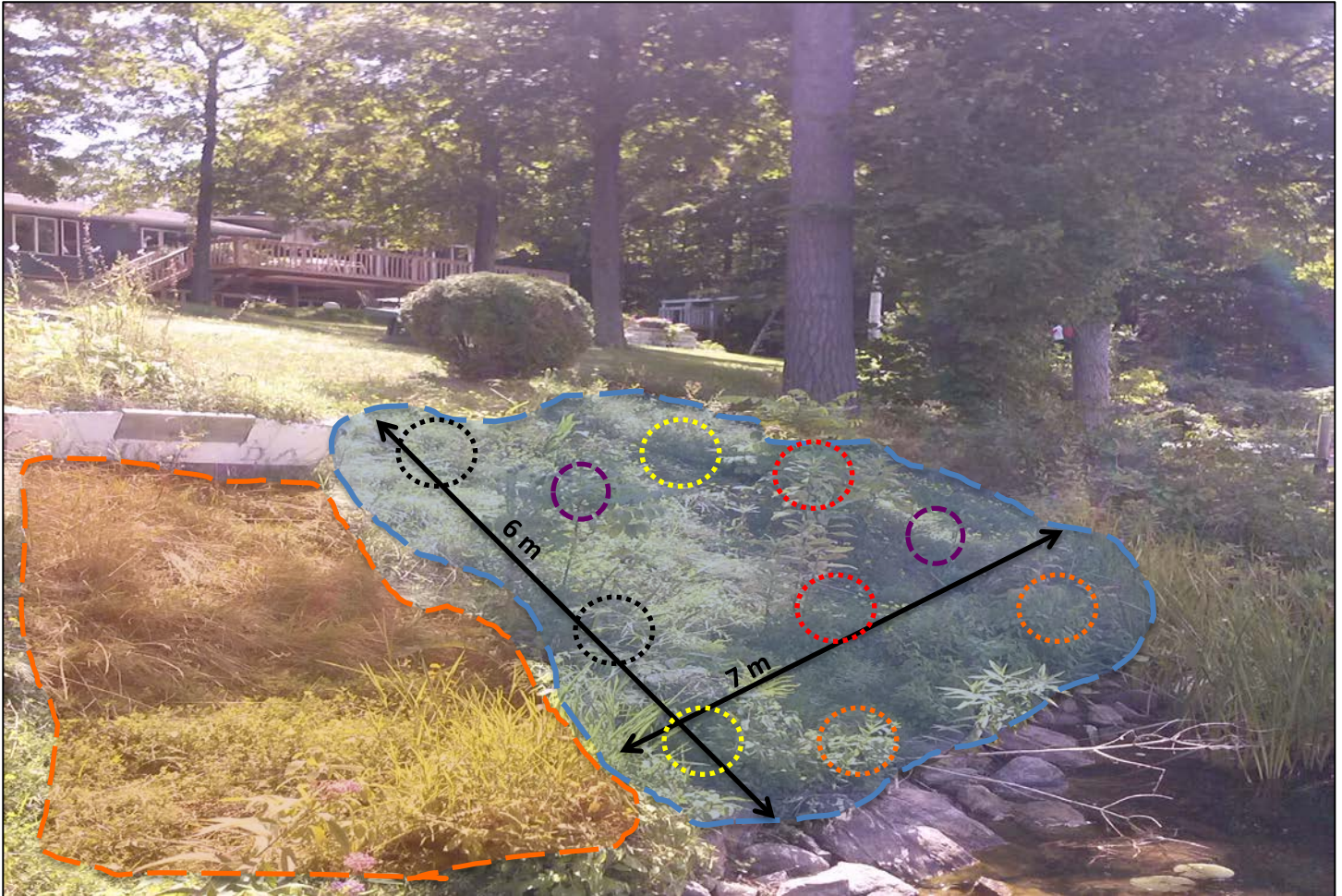



This compartment will be planted with bareroot low shrubs, high shrubs, and small trees.



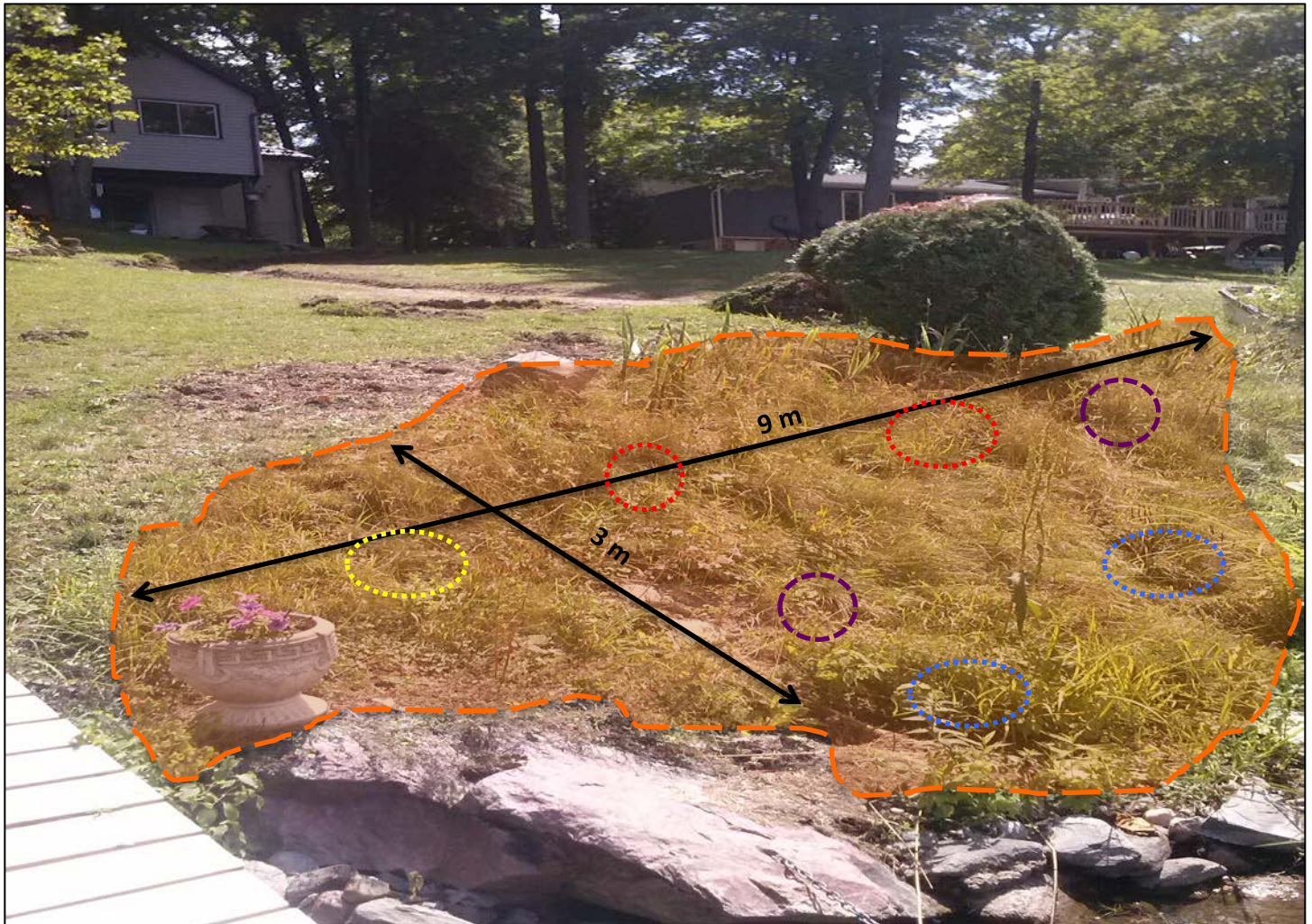

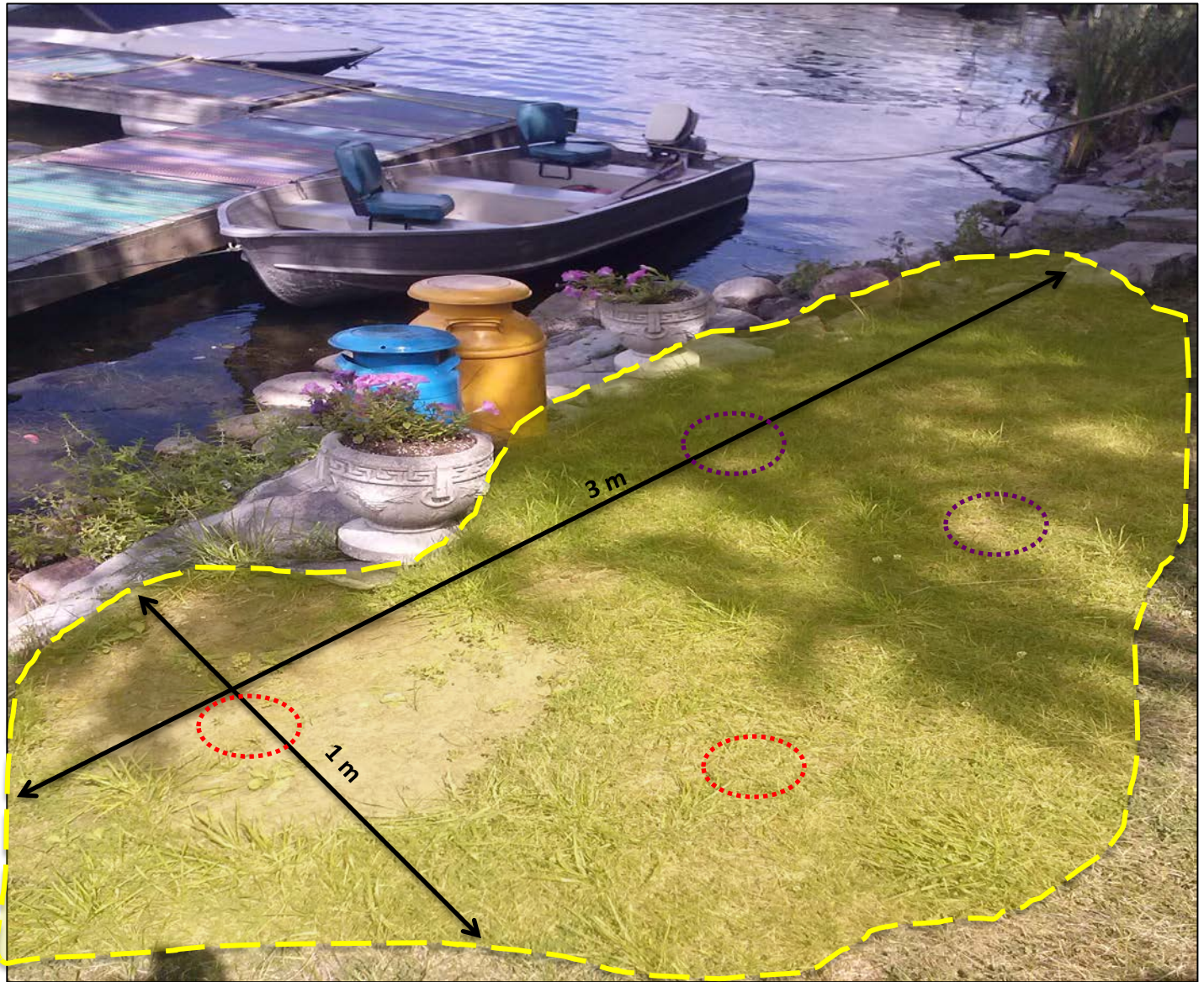

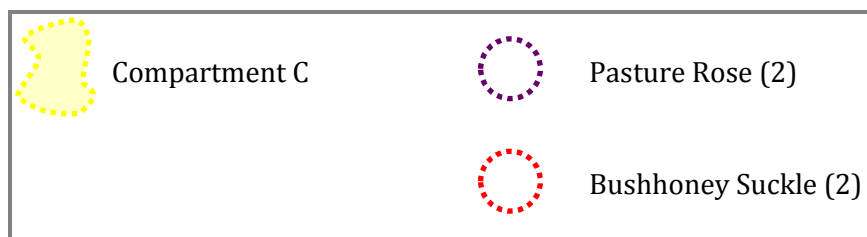

Silky Dogwood	<i>Cornus amomum</i>	3 m	Berries attracts birds, white flowers
Highbush Cranberry	<i>Viburnum trilobum</i>	3 m	Attracts most wildlife, red berries
Snowberry	<i>Symphoricarpus alba</i>	1 m	Clusters of white berries.
Red Maple	<i>Acer rubrum</i>	30 m	Deep scarlet foliage in Fall.
Meadowsweet	<i>Spiraea alba</i>	1-2 m	White flowers.
Pasture Rose	<i>Rosa carolina</i>	1 m	Light pink flowers.
Bush Honeysuckle	<i>Diervilla</i>	1 m	Yellow/orange flowers.
